

NAVA ADÉ CLUBHOUSE AND POOL POLICIES AND RULES – 2008

Hours of Operation

Seven days a week, 5:00 a.m.-9:45 p.m.

NOTE: The doors lock automatically at 10:00 p.m. sharp.

NOTE: In the following policies and rules, the term “clubhouse and pool” refers to any and all areas accessed from the locked front entrance of the clubhouse, including, but not limited to, the gym, steam room, rest rooms, meeting room, picnic area, hot tub, pool, and pool deck. The term “adult” refers to an individual age 18 or older.

Membership

- ❖ The clubhouse and pool are available only for the use of Nava Adé cardholders.
- ❖ Members must use their own keycards to access the facility.
- ❖ An adult cardholder may invite up to two guests per household to the clubhouse and pool; they must be accompanied by the cardholder while using the facility.
- ❖ Anyone entering the clubhouse and pool by any means other than the front door is in violation of clubhouse and pool rules.
- ❖ Members should be prepared to show ID when requested by our security company or a management company representative.

Age Limits

- ❖ The pool is reserved exclusively for adults from 5:00-9:00 a.m. daily.
- ❖ No children under the age of 14 are allowed at the clubhouse and pool unless accompanied by an adult while on the premises.
- ❖ No children under the age of 14 are allowed in the hot tub or steam room under any circumstances.

Capacity

- ❖ Maximum of 32 people in the pool at one time.
- ❖ Maximum of 6 people in the hot tub at one time.

This is your pool and you are responsible!

- ❖ There is no lifeguard on duty, so swim at your own risk.
- ❖ In an emergency, call 911 immediately on the emergency phone located by the hot tub.
- ❖ Use the rescue rings and hooks mounted inside the pool enclosure only in an emergency.
- ❖ Protect your own valuables. The HOA and the management company accept no responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, personal valuables at the pool or clubhouse.
- ❖ If you see anything that does not seem right or in violation of the rules, call HOAMCO at 954-4479 during the daytime, or Associated Security at 995-0440 after 5:00 p.m.

Please help to keep the pool and hot tub filters clean and functional.

- ❖ Take a soap shower prior to entering the pool to reduce the amount of lotions, deodorants, etc. that the filter has to process.
- ❖ Wear proper swim attire in the pool and hot tub. No colored T-shirts or street attire (especially cut-offs) are permitted. Threads clog the filters and colored dyes disturb the chemical balance.
- ❖ Be sure that all children who are not toilet-trained wear approved swimmers' diapers, or cloth diapers/training pants with tight-fitting rubber pants, while in the pool. (And please dispose of used diapers at home and not in the trash containers or restroom toilets.)
- ❖ Don't chew gum in the pool or pool area; it sticks to feet and filters!
- ❖ Don't consume any food or beverages in the pool or pool area. Please eat at the picnic area outside the pool gates. Only water in plastic bottles may be brought to the pool area.

Please be safe, and keep your friends and neighbors safe.

- ❖ Don't bring glass containers into the clubhouse and pool. (Broken glass poses an injury risk to everyone using the facility.)
- ❖ You may not bring alcoholic beverages to the clubhouse and pool.
- ❖ Leave your pets at home; they are not allowed in the clubhouse and pool.
- ❖ You are not allowed to smoke in the clubhouse and pool—fire danger, and the risk of someone stepping on a still-burning cigarette, are just too great.
- ❖ You should not enter the pool if you have bandages, open sores, or diseases of the eyes, ears, nose, throat, or skin.
- ❖ Leave the pool and hot tub during lightning/thunder storms.

Please be respectful of other members.

- ❖ Refrain from running, pushing, wrestling, diving, dunking, standing or sitting on shoulders, shouting, using profanity or abusive language, unnecessary splashing, throwing others in the pool, ball playing, or other actions causing a disturbance.
- ❖ You may not bring or use wheeled vehicles (other than wheelchairs and strollers) to the clubhouse and pool. This means no bikes, in-line skates, skateboards, etc.
- ❖ Confine radio/music listening to personal electronic devices with headphones; no boom boxes, portable TVs, or other sound devices are permitted in the clubhouse and pool if other members can hear them.
- ❖ Don't litter the pool deck or other facility areas. Clean up after yourselves and your guests and dispose of all trash appropriately.
- ❖ Keep the restrooms clean! Don't flush any clogging articles such as sanitary napkins, disposable diapers, or paper towels.

NOTE: Violations of pool and clubhouse rules may result in the assessment of a fine, denial of access to the facility, or prosecution. The cost of cleanup of graffiti or other defacement will be borne by the responsible party.
